

Information, Advice and Guidance (IAG) and Pastoral Support

Interview Skills

Following on from the Sutton Apprenticeship Hub launch at the Metro Bank, (Sutton) in November 2015, Sutton & District Training were successful in forming a working partnership with Sam Hilton & Gary Mellish from the Metro Bank.



Sam & Gary agreed to support our students and arranged mock interview situations to allow our students to gain valuable interview practice. This was held at the Metro Bank under a real working environment. In addition to their interviews, students were given the opportunity to take a tour around the bank and meet staff.

Feedback from Sam & Gary was very positive - ***“students were well presented, acted in a very professional manner and interacted with all staff”***

Apprenticeships

Since the launch, we are working very closely with the Sutton Apprenticeship Hub and have successfully placed a number of students into Apprenticeships within the Borough.

This started with Will Davis (an Endeavour Programme student) who was looking for a Carpentry Apprenticeship for his placement at Nescot College in September 2016. We advised Will to forward his CV to Lisa at the Sutton Apprenticeship Hub.

Lisa was extremely impressed with his CV and said - ***“this is one of the best CV’s I’ve seen for a very long time and I’ve seen a few!!”***



Lisa promoted and forwarded Will’s CV to various suitable organisations and within a short space of time, Will was successful in obtaining an interview at Elite Interiors, London. Upon a positive outcome from his interview, Will was offered 2 weeks work experience to develop his carpentry skills in-line with his College Apprenticeship at Nescot.

During the 2 weeks work experience, Will excelled and was offered a Carpentry Apprenticeship with Elite Interiors, London. Nina Haydon and Peter Webb were extremely pleased with Will - ***“really fortunate to have found Will, he is an invaluable addition to our partnership”***
