



Statement on the Use of the 16-19 Tuition Fund – September 2020

Sutton & District Training has received funding to support catch-up tuition for small groups of students whose education has been disrupted by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

The funding will be used to support small group tuition for students undertaking a Study Programme who have yet to achieve a GCSE grade 5 in English or maths and whose learning or achievements have been affected by the pandemic.

We will provide personalised support through small group sessions, additional tutoring and pastoral support, for eligible 16 – 19 students in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted. A mixture of face to face, practical abilities sessions and small intervention sessions will take place over and above the students normal timetabled arrangements.

Examples of some of the Tuition Support on offer will include

- Functional Skills assessment preparation
- Vocational practical support/catch-up
- Pastoral support
- GCSE exam preparation
- SEN support sessions
