

Statement on the Use of the 16-19 Tuition Fund – September 2021

Sutton & District Training has received funding (Sept 2020) to support catch-up tuition for small groups of students to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

The funding will be used to support small group tuition for students (up to 5 learners or in exceptional circumstances this may be extended to up to 7) who are undertaking a Study Programme and who have not previously achieved a grade 4 or above in either English or maths at GCSE. This includes those aged 19-24 who have an Education Health Care Plan.

The funding will allow us to extend the eligibility to include those who have a grade 4 or above in English and/or maths, are from an economically disadvantaged background and would need catch-up support.

We will provide personalised support through small group sessions, additional tutoring and pastoral support, for eligible 16 – 19 students in English, maths and other courses where learning has been disrupted. A mixture of face to face, practical abilities sessions and small intervention sessions will take place

Examples of some of the Tuition Support on offer will include:

- Functional Skills assessment preparation
- Vocational practical support/catch-up
- Pastoral support
- GCSE exam preparation
- SEN support sessions
